The village president requested to arrange the NSS camp for their village under the UBA and NSS activity

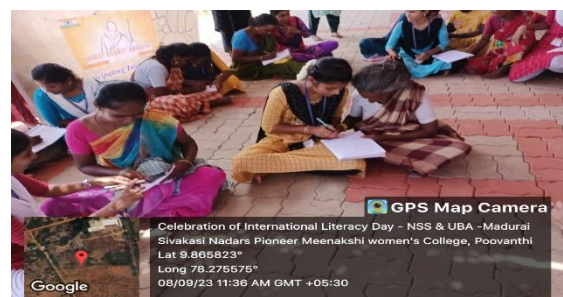
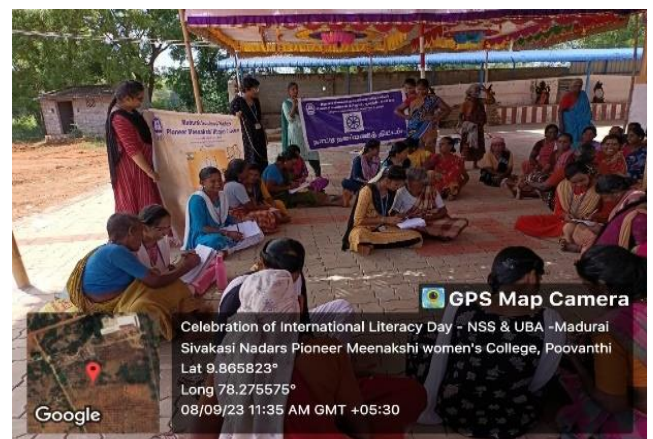
Cleaning Campaign Activity

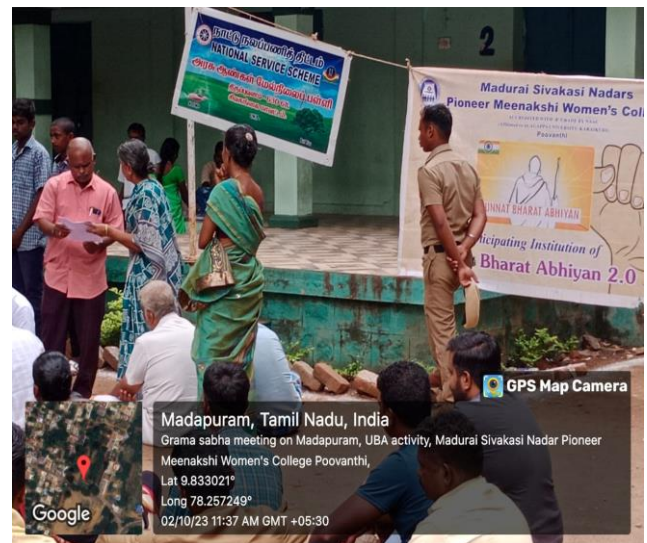


Grama Sabha Meeting at Madappuram
