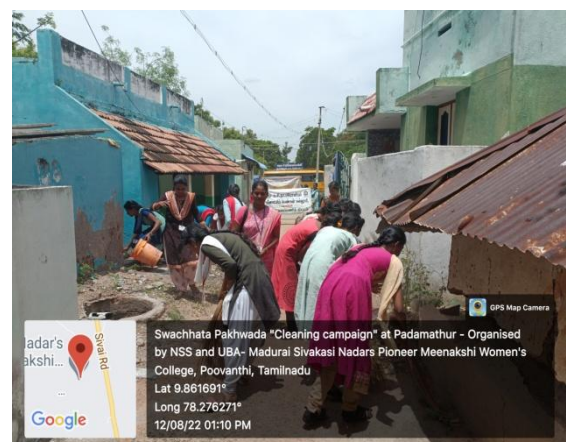
Seminar on Awareness against Drug abuse

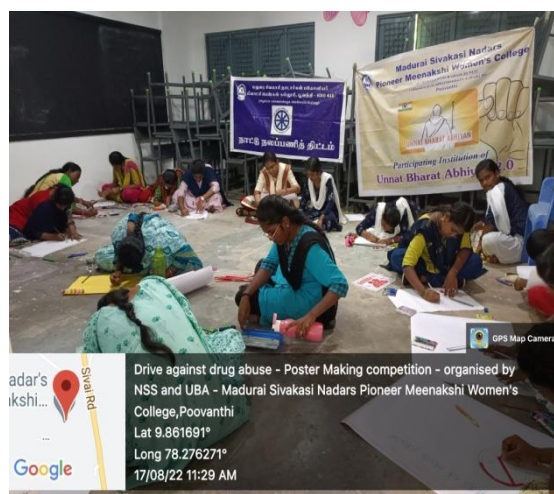
Celebration of 75th Independence Day

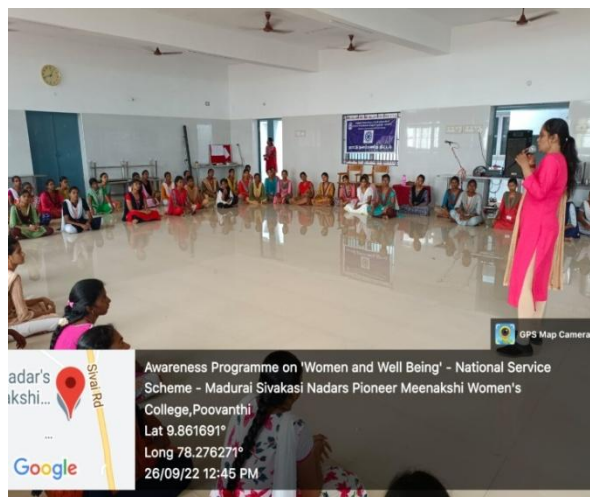
Health Checkup
