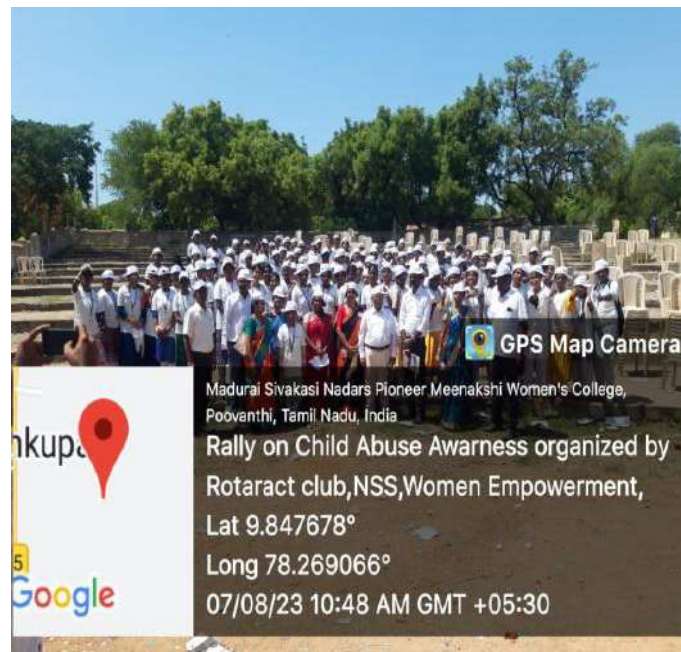
“PROJECT PUNCH” – A THREE DAY SPOKEN ENGLISH PROGRAMME
