4. Requisition for road



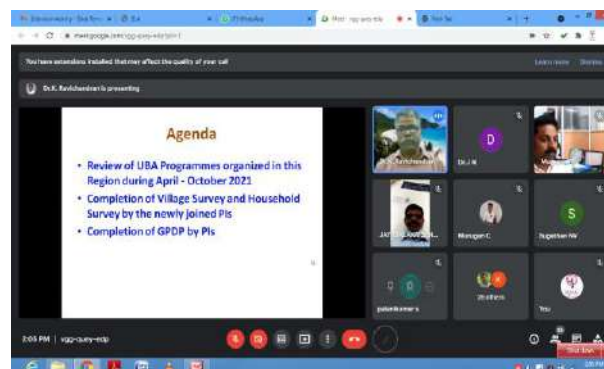
An awareness programme on “Avoid the use of single usage plastics”
